


A Message from Your Priest in Charge

Again and again we are invited to make the choice. Choose life!



September Vestry Meeting Highlights

The regular monthly meeting of the Priest in charge, Wardens and Vestry was held on Tuesday, November 24, 2020 via Zoom. The minutes of the previous meeting were approved. The Income & Expense Report for the period ending October 31, 2020 was distributed. The report of the Treasurer was accepted subject to audit.

- The actions of the Little Lamb, Shepherd's Haven and Thrift Shoppe management groups were ratified.
- The November Fish & Chips fundraiser made about \$800. We won't be able to have Breakfast with Santa or a Christmas craft sale.!
- On November 8, Father Stephen and Deacon Barbara delivered communion to about 15 homes.
- The Sunday School children can't make cookies this year, but we will try to organize some type of delivery to our Christ Church shut-ins. We are working on the possibility of a virtual Christmas pageant.
- There will be a Blue Christmas service on December 20. It is too soon to know what type of Christmas service we will have. .

The minutes of the Vestry meeting will be posted on the bulletin board in the Parish Hall as they become available. The next meeting will be held on Tuesday, December 22, 2020.


Calling All Pageanteers!


