


A Message from Your Priest in Charge



Dear Friends,

It seems like we're living in the meantime; the time in between now and what the Church will be and look like a year from now. I really don't know.

Actually, we have always lived in the meantime. It begins with today. We're put on this earth for a limited time. It is the meantime.

One of the ingredients of our present meantime is uncertainty. Will Church ever be the same again? It's uncertain. The tendency is to be more comfortable when things are certain, but I want to suggest that it can be much more powerful when we live in the arena of uncertainty.

Uncertainty within the Church context has allowed us to create a new way of worshipping. The attendance of our weekly Facebook service is 10 times more than the usual attendance on Sunday mornings. The daily meditations have been received enthusiastically. They are like short homilies. Who would have thought of that?

I've always wanted to officiate a funeral before a person dies. This happened with David Christensen, our Music Director. Five children shared a favorite memory of him via the phone. He died enveloped in love. It doesn't make sense to me that we say the most wonderful memories of people at their funeral!

Living in the uncertainty of now is really an invitation to redesign our lives like never before. I have met more neighbors in the past month than I have in the previous 10 years.

Uncertainty – it can be a miserable time of being uncomfortable, or it can be a delightful time of being creative. We get to choose the arena in which we live.

April Vestry Meeting Highlights

The regular monthly meeting of the Priest in charge, Wardens and Vestry was held on Tuesday, March 24, 2020 via conference call. The minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

- The Income & Expense Report for the period ending March 31, 2020 was distributed.

- Little Lamb Children's Center closed on April 1. Shepherd's Haven and the Thrift Shoppe remain closed.

- The Church will apply for a Payroll Protection Program loan through the Small Business Association of the government. There are terms under which the loan may be forgiven.

- We have applied for a \$10,000 loan through the Diocese which is for general operation expenses.

- The altar project is on hold.

- We will go ahead with the Fish & Chips fundraiser on 5/8. It will be take-out only. The Tricky Tray will be postponed until 8/28. The Beefsteak Dinner will be postponed until 10/17. We will plan a Church Fair, including outside vendors, for 11/7.

- We are mourning the loss of our Music Director, David Christensen. We won't be able to have a funeral at this time. His family is planning something in St. Croix. We will make an announcement when Fr. Stephen is able to conduct a funeral for Dave. At some point, we will have a search for a new organist.

The minutes of the Vestry meeting will be posted on the

bulletin board in the Parish Hall as they become available. The next meeting will be held on Tuesday, May 26, 2020.
